The classic Goldridge soils, the vineyard's rolling hills and a southeastern exposure combine to impart great depth, complexity and character to our Estate Wines.

The 2019 Rosé with a light coral color is a fruit-forward wine with notes of apricot and peach. The aromas of the wine offer notes of passion fruit, grapefruit juice, and cantaloupe.
